

Ministering Today Kym Wade

This morning, I want to continue to look at the fundamentals of the Christian Faith. So far we have looked at prayer, God's word, faith and worship.

We are going to continue looking at worship today. Worship is not just a song we sing on Sunday morning; it is much, much, more than this.

In Deuteronomy 6:4-5 (ESV) it says, "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might."

Jesus said that this was the most important commandment and there was another just like it, "To love your neighbour as yourself".

In Exodus 20:3 it says, "You shall have no other gods before me." Our God is a jealous God and He will not have our affections divided between this world and Him. He requires all of us.

So how does this look like in our everyday lives? There are many things in this world that can distract us and take away from our relationship with God. We live in a frail human body and have many needs every day that must be met for us to live. Not only that we have emotions, and these emotions have a huge effect on how we respond to the experiences of our everyday life. Often life can feel like it is to much for us, we have all experienced this.
