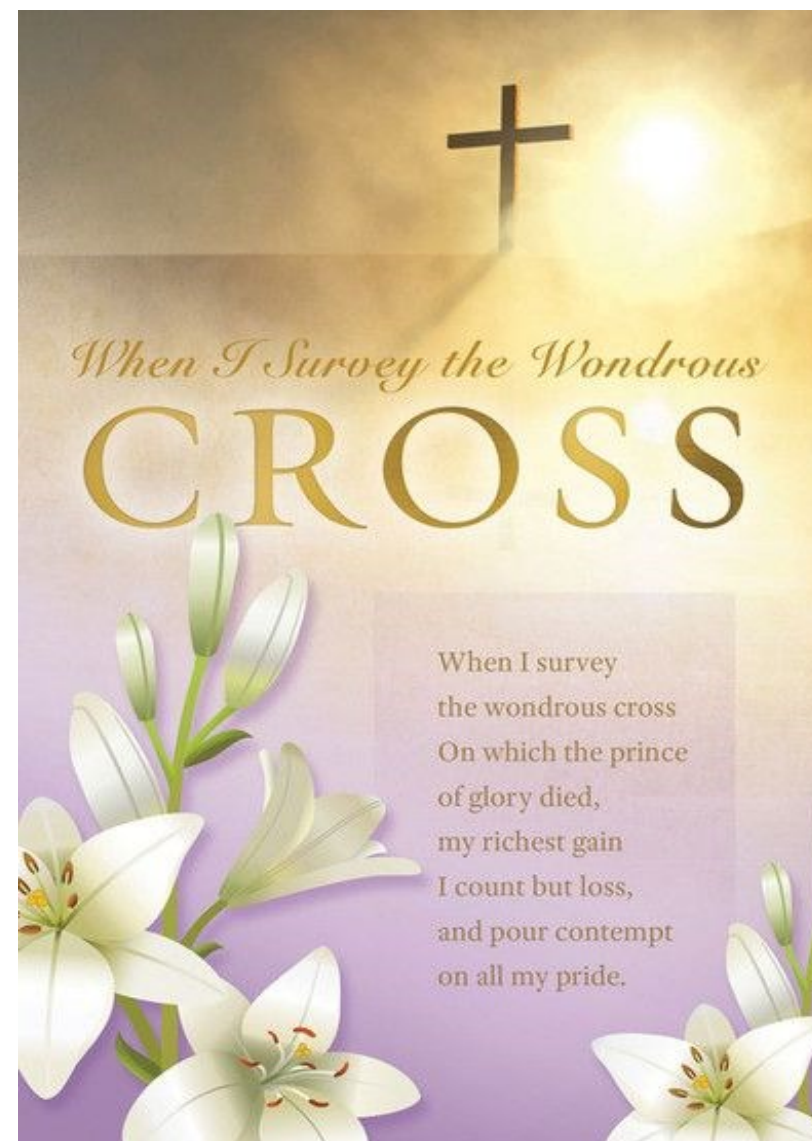

Today we are going to be spending more time studying the “Three Aspects of the One Cross of Christ.” We will identify that Jesus died For Us (Once) sins of the unregenerate flesh, (Ephesians 2:1). He died As Us (Once) that we would be dead to sin, the Old Man passed away in completely delivered from the power of darkness (Colossians 1:13). He died that we would be delivered from ourselves a living sacrifice (Daily) as we surrender to Him in our lives, holy, and acceptable unto God. (Romans 12:1). This I believe is the very foundation of our Christian Walk.

Matthew 16:24-25. 24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. 25 For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it.

What a powerful scripture this is, one that should be indelibly imprinted upon every part of our heart, mind and soul. A scripture that should so inspire us to attain to its direction that we focus upon it with a zeal to fulfill that only the Holy Spirit can provide. We should recognise within this scripture the choice between eternal life and eternal death, a choice that Jesus gives us with an assurance that if we are obedient to Him and His Word, He will bring this to pass,

Philippians 1:6 (NKJV) 6 being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;

May the truth of this important, factual doctrine so encourage you and enliven you to move forward in these Cross provided provisions of our Christ. To use a colloquialism “The ball is in our court”. He (Jesus) has done all.
