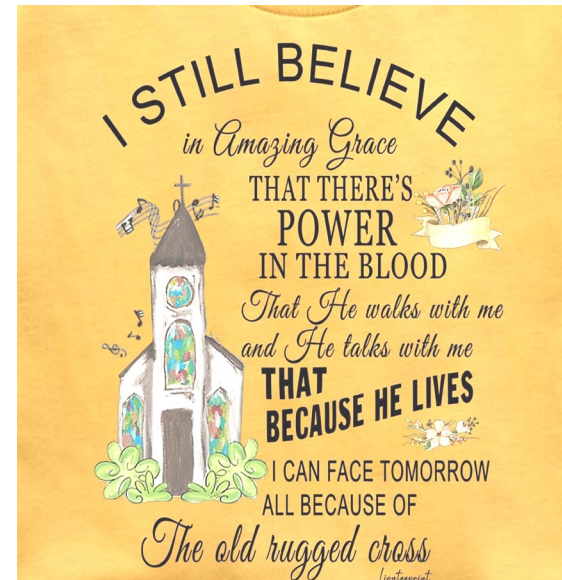
Ministering Today Kym Wade

Luke 10:41-42 (ESV) ⁴¹ But the Lord answered her, “Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things, ⁴² but one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the good portion, which will not be taken away from her.”

What was the good thing that Mary chose? It was to sit at the feet of Jesus and listen to His teaching. Martha had invited Jesus to her home, she felt responsible for looking after him and all those who came with Him. This seems quite reasonable to me! But I think that the trouble was that she was anxious and worried about many things. Her head was full of the noise of the responsibilities of life and she was missing the very best part, to sit at Jesus feet and listen. She had invited Jesus into her home, that was the first step. She now had His full attention and time. Mary saw the opportunity and instead of serving at the table she sat at Jesus’ feet.
