Today I am continuing my teaching on entering the Rest of God. This is such an important topic for us to understand and be able to apply this freedom that God has provided for us. It has always been His intention that we should rest in Him, that we should enter His Rest. It was His intention for the children of Israel to enter His rest and they refused to do so through lack of trust and disobedience as we saw in the last teaching, however, He clearly states that it is still His purpose for His people to enter this rest that He has provided.

Hebrews 4:8 (NKJV) ⁸ For if Joshua had given them rest, then He would not afterward have spoken of another day. ⁹ There remains therefore a rest for the people of God. ¹⁰ For he who has entered His rest has himself also ceased from his works as God did from His.

Obedience and trust is the key to entering this state of rest spoken of by God. We will be looking at the beauty of entering His rest today

'The Rest' that God provides for all those who believe in His authority and power is realised when we completely surrender to Him as Lord. Not just Saviour, but Lord in every area of our lives.
