Ministering Peter Dart

Today I again continue my teaching on entering the Rest of God. This is such an important topic for us to understand and apply. It has always been God's intention that we should rest in Him, enter His Rest. It was available for the children of Israel, and they refused to do so through lack of faith, unbelief and disobedience as we saw in the last teaching, however, He clearly states that it is still His purpose for His people to enter this rest He has provided.

Hebrews 4:8 (NKJV) 8 For if Joshua had given them rest, then He would not afterward have spoken of another day. 9 There remains therefore a rest for the people of God. 10 For he who has entered His rest has himself also ceased from his works as God did from His.

Obedience, trust and complete faith are the keys. We are now completely empowered by the indwelling Holy Spirit to enter this state of rest spoken of by God. That state is further realised only in the state of complete surrender to the directions of the Holy Spirit as He leads us in the same calling that Jesus had in His earthly ministry. As He surrendered to the direction of the Father, so are we called to do so. There is no exception. Jesus must be Lord in every area of our lives. There is no room for pride or any self-exultation, only complete humble submission to the direction of the Holy Spirit and unconditional surrender.

Isaiah 28:11-12 (NKJV) 11 For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people, 12 To whom He said, "This is the rest with which You may cause the weary to rest," And, "This is the refreshing"; Yet they would not hear.

Paul identifies this statement in the New Testament as the gift of tongues that is uniquely gifted through the infilling of the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 14:21-22 (NKJV) 21 In the law it is written: "With men of other tongues and other lips I will speak to this people; And yet, for all that, they will not hear Me," says the Lord.

What is it a sign of? That the person speaking in tongues is gifted to do so by the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit. They are identified as the chosen, gifted, Ambassadors of the Kingdom of God. It is my earnest prayer that today we will be challenged to accept this equipping, abandon all areas of pride and selfishness and truly embrace our calling.

Romans 12:1-2 (NKJV) 12 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
